<b>A</b> <b>90-100 points</b>	<p>Paper/report is engaging, creative, and thoughtful</p> <p>Writing is precise, vivid, and sophisticated vocabulary; varied patterns and lengths of sentences</p> <p>Narrative is coherent and organized structure and allows the voice of the interviewee to “speak”</p> <p>Details chosen form effectively and innovatively, thereby, allowing the piece to convey content, ideas, and perceptions</p> <p>Paper / report presents relevant and intriguing information through use of details to convey personality and experience of person interviewed</p> <p>Paper /report contains few surface feature errors; only noticeable if looking for them</p>
<b>B</b> <b>89 – 80 points</b>	<p>Paper / report is clear and thoughtful</p> <p>Writing is complex, precise vocabulary and varied sentences</p> <p>The paper / report s written with logical organization</p> <p>Details chosen form effectively conveys content</p> <p>Paper /report presents relevant and careful use of details to convey personality and experience of person interviewed</p> <p>Paper / report contains few surface feature errors; occasional spelling or punctuation errors</p>
<b>C</b> <b>79 – 70 points</b>	<p>Paper / report is somewhat developed and detailed</p> <p>Writing uses somewhat precise vocabulary and complex sentence structures which contains minimal errors</p> <p>Some obvious organization</p> <p>A few details chosen form appropriate for content</p> <p>Paper / report presents some relevant use of details to convey personality and experience of person interviewed</p> <p>Several surface feature errors; some punctuation, spelling, or pronoun reference errors</p>
